SUNDAY OF THE PUBLICAN AND PHARISEE: TRIODION BEGINS TODAY



The Pharisees were an ancient and outstanding sect among the Jews known for their diligent observance of the outward matters of the Law. Although, according to the word of our Lord, they "did all their works to be seen of men" (Matt. 23:5), and were hypocrites (ibid. 23:13, 14, 15, etc.), because of the apparent holiness of their lives they were thought by all to be righteous, and separate from others, which is what the name Pharisee means. On the other

hand, Publicans, collectors of the royal taxes, committed many injustices and extortions for filthy lucre's sake, and all held them to be sinners and unjust. It was therefore according to common opinion that the Lord Jesus in His parable signified a virtuous person by a Pharisee, and a sinner by a Publican, to teach His disciples the harm of pride and the profit of humble-mindedness.

Since the chief weapon for virtue is humility, and the greatest hindrance to it is pride, the divine Fathers have set these three weeks before the Forty-day Fast as a preparation for the spiritual struggles of virtue. This present week they have called Harbinger, since it declares that the Fast is approaching; and they set humility as the foundation for all our spiritual labors by appointing that the parable of the Publican and the Pharisee be read today, even before the Fast begins, to teach, through the vaunting of the Pharisee, that the foul smoke of self-esteem and the stench of boasting drives away the grace of the Spirit, strips man of all his virtue, and casts him into the pits of Hades; and, through the repentance and contrite prayer of the Publican, that humility confers upon the sinner forgiveness of all his wicked deeds and raises him up to the greatest heights.

All foods are allowed the week that follows this Sunday.

Apolytikion of the Feast

Lady full of grace, rejoice, O Virgin Theotokos, for Christ our God, the Sun of righteousness has risen from you and He illumined those in darkness. And you, righteous Elder, be glad in heart, receiving in your embraces the One who liberates our souls and bestows on us the Resurrection.

Apolytikion of Pentecost (for the Holy Trinity)

Blessed are You, O Christ our God, who made fishermen all-wise, sending upon them the Holy Spirit and, through them, netting the world. O Loving One, glory to You.

Apolytikion of the Prophet Elias

The incarnate Angel, the Cornerstone of the Prophets, the second Forerunner of the Coming of Christ, the glorious Elias (Elijah), who from above, sent down to Elisha the grace to dispel sickness and cleanse lepers, abounds therefore in healing for those who honor him.

THE GOSPEL



The reading is from the holy Gospel according to Luke
(18:10–14)

The Lord said this parable, “Two men went up into the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, ‘God, I thank you that I am not like other men, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week, I give tithes of all that I get.’ But the tax collector, standing far off, would not even lift up his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, ‘God, be merciful to me a sinner!’ I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other; for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but he who humbles himself will be exalted.”



REAL ESTATE COMMITTEE REPORT

We are pleased to report that the Real Estate Committee (REC) is finalizing negotiations with the Woodbury Corporation. We recognize this has taken a long time, and the delays have created a lot of questions and concerns in the community. This is a very complex and difficult transaction, and we have endeavored to be as diligent and thorough as possible. We have also made changes along the way as we have listened to questions and concerns of fellow parishioners and have adapted the document accordingly, which made it difficult to keep everyone updated as things were adjusting.

When the REC began soliciting offers, we started with a guiding set of principles. We have strived to review any offers or proposals, including the Woodbury one, through the lens of the following:

1. **We are a Church** - Focus on Ministries and spreading the **Gospel**, not on running a business.
2. **We need a Community Center** - Our main priority is the overwhelming need to provide a new community center. Any project must prioritize the construction of the **Community Center**.
3. **Keep our Land** - We will not subordinate or pledge our land. Our property will remain with the community. If there is any debt to complete the Community Center, it will be unsecured.
4. **Find a Development Partner** that is ***Institutional, Credible, Reputable, and Financially Stable***, with prior experience in long-term land leases and a strong presence in Utah.
5. **Greek Festival** - Maintain enough space and infrastructure (kitchen, etc.) to continue the **Greek Festival**.
6. **Create an income stream** for community solvency and **financial stability** for the next 100 years.

The Parish has given direction to the REC and Parish Council over the past few years to advance the negotiations of Term Sheets and this Final Lease Document, consistent with the above-noted principles. The most recent Special Parish Assembly action which passed in 2021 stated the following:

“Bill Paulos made a motion to have The Assembly move to approve the negotiated Term Sheet as presented by the Parish Council and Real Estate Committee, and to negotiate through its outside legal counsel a final Ground Lease Contract with the Woodbury Corporation to be considered for approval at a Special Parish Assembly which shall be scheduled after the Greek Festival 2021. Motion was seconded by Christian Priskos. Motion passed with 71 in favor and 4 against.”





WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

The Real Estate Committee will hold several informational meetings during February and March. At least one will be in person, and one will be electronic. Everyone will leave the meetings with a copy of the lease and background documents. *These will not be to "sell the project", they will be informational!* A decision of this magnitude has positives and negatives, and we will be prepared to address both. It's important that everyone has an opportunity to consider and weigh complete and accurate information for themselves.

Lastly, there will be a Special Parish Assembly, likely in March to have final discussions and debates where we will take a vote. We are coordinating the date of that meeting in conjunction with the Parish Council.

We recognize that because we were unable to bring this to a vote sooner, it has left a lot of people to question things about the deal structure and the plan. As mentioned before, we have been taking input and making adjustments along the way. That has created many misconceptions and rumors about things like parking, the Cathedral Square, how the Community Center is finished, etc. If you would like accurate and up to date information about those things prior to the informational meetings, we encourage you to call one of us.

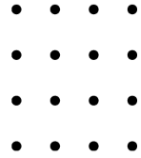

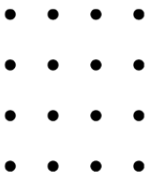
